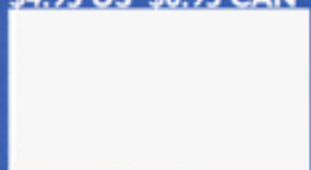

Medium Cargo Bag

From the moment this bag arrived it quickly became a favorite tool of the Modern Nomad™ staff and interns. It is utilitarian and trendy with tons of cool and useful compartments: one exterior diagonal zipper compartment useful for carrying magazines and journals, one exterior portfolio pocket, one large main interior space with three small pockets, wallet space, key clip and business card holder. One of this bag's most inventive options is the seat belt clasp that secures the bag and when opened reveals a crescent-shaped zippered pocket with an attached pouch. This bag is waterproof, contains a built in exterior cell phone holder, and also sports an extremely comfortable and adjustable shoulder strap that allows it to be carried as a sling bag, or for more formal situations one can use the briefcase handles.
